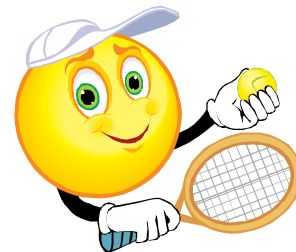

## LEGO LEAGUE—2010/2011 SCHOOL YEAR PROGRAM

The Hudson Division of Recreation is planning to offer an after-school/evening Lego League (FLL) program for elementary school age students. FLL is a global program created to get kids excited about science and technology. Our program will be broken down into teams for grades 1, 2, and 3, and grades 4 and 5. FLL utilizes theme-based challenges to engage kids in research, problem-solving and engineering. The cornerstones of FLL are its core values, which emphasize the contributions of others, friendly sportsmanship, learning and community involvement.

*This program was developed through a grant from Intel and conducted at the Mulready School last year. We will expand into both Farley and Forest Avenue schools if there are a sufficient number of volunteers interested, as well as participants.*
