Patrick Thayer reported that he had been pulling barberry at Danforth, and had done an introductory walkthrough with Ken Skudder. He would like to have a large Tree of Heaven at the Skate Park removed and replaced with native trees. Patrick and Pam Helinek are meeting with Recreation Director Steven Santos next week to discuss the details. James Martin requested that the tree be replaced with a large tree sapling, and that other larger plants be included in spring plantings.
