Meeting Minutes March 30, 2022

Pursuant to the Chapter 20 of the Acts of 2021 Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, this meeting of the Hudson Ad-hoc Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee was conducted via remote participation.

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 4:01 PM by Mr. Green.

The following voting members were in attendance: Tom McCoy, Frank Noyes and Tom Green. Robert Naiman joined the meeting at 4:03 and Kelly Shultz joined the meeting at 4:04.

The following ex-officio members were in attendance: Pam Helinek and Kali Coughlan.

Community members Brian Smith joined the meeting at 4:04 and Joshua Stone at 4:10.

Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Noyes made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 16, 2022 meeting. Mr. McCoy seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously (3-0) by a roll call vote.

Plan outline:

Mr. Noyes had reviewed the Malden Bike Plan and indicated that it contained a lengthy overview of the city. Is that something that we would include in our document? Since our charter is to deliver a

document to the Select Board, Mr. Green thought that there wouldn't need to be any description of the town in the document.

Community Survey:

Ms. Coughlan created a survey based on the regional bike survey done by Cape Ann Mass in Motion. The committee reviewed the full survey, providing comments and suggestions for modifications. There was a discussion about how subjects could identify where they live so that we can analyze responses by neighborhood. Mr. Green will prepare a map of town with numbered sections for the committee to review.

Identifying priority streets:

Mr. Green reviewed a document and a map that he prepared showing the streets identified as priorities, or ones recommended for improvements in previous reports done for the town and/or schools.

Adjournment:

Ms. Shultz made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:24. Mr. McCoy seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously (5-0) by a roll call vote.
