

## Instructions Regarding Motor Vehicle Excise Tax

### IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX

#### IF YOU HAVE MOVED FROM HUDSON BUT STILL LIVE IN MASSACHUSETTS

If you moved from Hudson prior to January 1<sup>st</sup> of the year of registration but still reside in Massachusetts, please return the following to the Assessing Office:

Motor Vehicle Excise Tax Bill  
A copy of a bill dated prior to January 1<sup>st</sup> with your name and new address

If you moved from Hudson after January 1<sup>st</sup>, you must pay this bill in full to the Town of Hudson.

#### IF YOU HAVE MOVED FROM MASSACHUSETTS

If you moved out of Massachusetts prior to January 1<sup>st</sup> of the year of registration, please return the following to the Assessing Office:

Motor Vehicle Excise Tax Bill  
New State Registration **and**  
Massachusetts Plate Return Receipt

If you moved out of Massachusetts after January 1<sup>st</sup> of the year of registration, please return the following to the Assessing Office:

Motor Vehicle Excise Tax Bill  
New State Registration **and**  
Massachusetts Plate Return Receipt

#### IF YOU HAVE SOLD OR TRADED YOUR VEHICLE

If you have sold or traded the vehicle for which you are being billed, please return the following to the Assessing Office:

Motor Vehicle Excise Tax Bill  
Bill of Sale/Purchase and Sales agreement **and**  
Plate Return Receipt/New Registration

#### IF YOUR VEHICLE WAS STOLEN OR DECLARED A TOTAL LOSS

If your vehicle has been declared a total loss as a result of an accident, please return the following to the Assessing Office:

Motor Vehicle Excise Tax Bill  
A letter from your Insurance Company indicating the date of loss **and**  
Plate Return Receipt/New Registration

If your vehicle has been stolen, please return the following to the Assessing Office:

Motor Vehicle Excise Tax Bill  
Police Report indicating theft and date of notification **and**  
Plate Return Receipt / New Registration / Lost Plate Receipt
