### **MINUTES**

April 5, 2021 5:30pm Remote via Zoom

#### **New Business**

#### 1. Preliminaries:

- a. Ms. Vaillancourt called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.
- b. Roll Call: Ms. Vaillancourt, Mr. Delfino and Mr. Murphy
- **2. Approval of Minutes from 3.1.2021:** Mr. Delfino motioned to approve minutes, Mr. Murphy seconded the motion and it passed 3-0.
- **3. Vouchers to be Approved:** Mr. Murphy motioned to approve the vouchers as a block, Mr. Delfino seconded the motion and it passed 3-0. Due to COVID-19, Ms. Vaillancourt will have authority to sign the vouchers on behalf of the Board.

### 4. Grease Trap Variance Requests:

- **a. 43 Broad St:** Mr. Delfino motioned to approve the variance request for 43 Broad Street, given that the proposed Schier #GB-2 in-floor manual grease trap is cleaned on a monthly basis, Mr. Murphy seconded the motion and it passed 3-0.
- **b. 111 Main St:** Mr. Delfino motioned to deny the variance request for 111 Main Street, Mr. Murphy seconded the motion and it passed 3-0. The Board of Health will require the automatic grease interceptor to be installed at that location.
- **5. Emerson Hospital Grant:** The department has been awarded a \$5,000 grant for Youth Emotional CPR (eCPR) from Emerson Hospital.
- **6. Public Health Excellence Grant:** Ms. Calo informed the towns of Ashland, Framingham, Hopkinton, Hudson, Maynard, Milford, Mills and Natick submitted an application to DPH for the Public Health Excellence Grant to fill gaps in public health in the region. The grant is for three years and Hudson would be the lead municipality.

### **Old Business**

### 1. COVID-19 Update:

- **a.** Vaccination Clinic Update: Ms. Calo informed the Board that our last COVID-19 clinic will be on April 9<sup>th</sup>. We will have clinics at 3 sites: Brigham St, Glen St and Quinn Middle School and will complete vaccinations for 328 people.
- **b.** Homebound Vaccinations: Ms. Calo informed the Board that the Town has opted in to utilize the State's homebound program. Residents must call and answer a series of questions in order to qualify for the Johnson and Johnson vaccine.
