The first parking spot located in front of 4 Washington Street, immediately to the east of the crosswalk, will be designated as "handicapped".*
- b) Select Board to consider amending the Traffic Rules & Regulations Under Section 10 Town Hall Parking add the following: *The last two spaces on the westerly side of Church Street at the first driveway entrance to Avidia Bank Monday Friday between the hours of 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM.*
