



Hudson Conservation Commission New Member Interviews

The Hudson Conservation Commission is looking for a Hudson resident interested in protecting the environment and would value expertise in storm water hydrology and civil engineering, although this is not required. The Commission will be conducting interviews for a new member on January 7, 2020 at 7:00PM.

The primary task of the Conservation Commission is to permit work near wetlands and waterbodies under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act by considering impacts of storm water, vegetation changes, erosion and other disturbance on the wetland and its associated plant and wildlife communities. The Commission meets first and third Thursday evenings each month and occasionally has site visits on other evenings or weekend mornings.
