HUDSON COVID-19 UPDATE

From Monday, March 30 to Monday, April 6, 2020, the Hudson Board of Health was informed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) about 16 additional Hudson residents with a confirmed positive test result for COVID-19. The number of residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 in Hudson is now 26.
