There were **108** new confirmed COVID-19 cases in Hudson from 9.15.22 to 11.29.2022. Please note that the HHD only reports official cases communicated to us via the state's database (i.e. not at-home tests).

Wastewater Report

Wastewater data tells you the amount of COVID-19 virus in Middlesex County wastewater. When there is more virus in the wastewater, there are likely more people with COVID-19 in the community. This means that the risk of contracting COVID-19 may be higher.

From 9/15/22 to 11/29/22 the amount of virus in wastewater decreased in the last 6 weeks. A decrease in virus in the wastewater usually predicts a drop in COVID-19 cases.
