
Attention Hudson Residents:

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health has raised the EEE risk level for Hudson to "high". It is very important to take personal preventative actions like using repellents and avoiding peak mosquito activity (dawn and dusk). Also, avoid overnight camping particularly near freshwater swamps where EEE is most likely.


The Hudson Board of Health is working closely with the Central Mass Mosquito Control Project and the Massachusetts Department of Public Health on next steps. The attached map includes streets that will be sprayed early next week (date to be determined by the Central Mass Mosquito Control Project, but as soon as possible).

Key to Color Coding on EEE Risk Map		
Risk	What it Means	What You Can Do
Remote	EEE is not usually found in your area	<ul> <li>TO Prepare</li> <li>Know your risk – check regularly at www.mass.gov/dph/wnv</li> <li>Repair screens</li> </ul>
Low	EEE may occur in your area	<ul> <li>TO Prevent</li> <li>Wear mosquito repellent between dusk to dawn</li> <li>Wear long sleeves and long pants from dusk to dawn</li> <li>Use mosquito netting on baby carriages and playpens</li> </ul>
Moderate	EEE occurred in your area within the last year AND/OR there is EEE in mosquitoes in your area now	<ul> <li>TO Prevent – add this</li> <li>Wear mosquito repellent when outdoors, especially between dusk a dawn</li> <li>Avoid outside areas with obvious mosquito activity</li> </ul>
High	Conditions likely to lead to infection of a person with EEE are occurring in your area	<ul> <li>TO Prevent – add this</li> <li>Adjust outdoor activity to avoid peak mosquito hours (from dusk to dawn)</li> <li>Avoid overnight camping, particularly near freshwater swamps when EEE activity is most likely</li> </ul>
Critical	Excessive risk from EEE virus exists, a person with EEE infection has been identified in your area	<ul> <li>TO Prevent – add this</li> <li>Cancel or reschedule outdoor gatherings, organized sporting events etc. to avoid peak mosquito hours (dusk to dawn)</li> </ul>
