HUDSON COVID-19 UPDATE

From Monday, November 9 to Monday, November 16, 2020, the Hudson Board of Health was informed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) about 52 additional Hudson residents with a confirmed positive test result for COVID-19. The number of residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 in Hudson is now 417.

This week marks the week with the highest amount of cases throughout this pandemic in Hudson. The COVID-19 pandemic is not over. Please wear a mask, physically distance, and wash your hands. If you feel sick, stay home. Stop gathering. We are all in this together, and we need your help to stop the spread.

Get Tested! Stop the Spread:

- Testing is not restricted to residents of the cities where sites are located

- No cost to you
- Out-of-state residents are not eligible for free testing under the Stop the Spread program


