HUDSON COVID-19 UPDATE

From Monday, November 23 to Monday, November 30, 2020, the Hudson Board of Health was informed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) about 65 additional Hudson residents with a confirmed positive test result for COVID-19. The number of residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 in Hudson is now 527.


