## HUDSON COVID-19 UPDATE

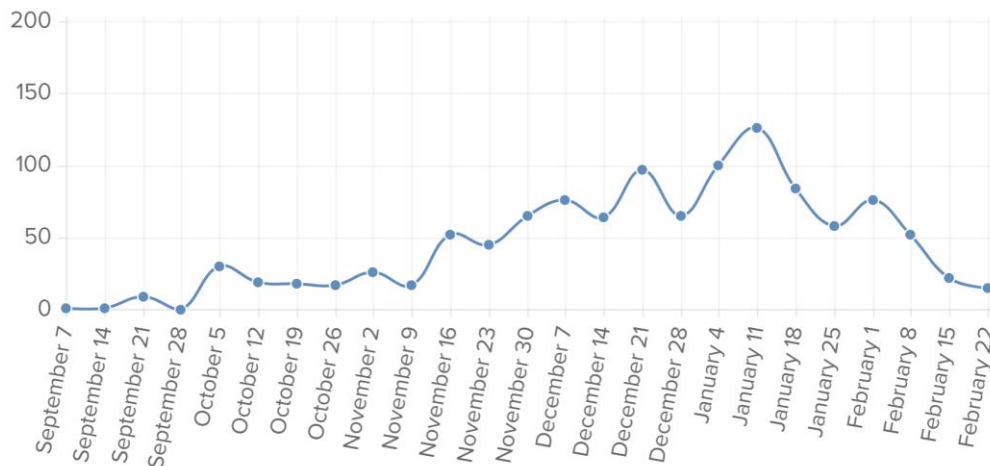
From Monday, February 15 to Monday, February 22, 2021, the Hudson Board of Health was informed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) about 15 additional Hudson residents with a confirmed positive test result for COVID-19. The number of residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 in Hudson is now 1362.
