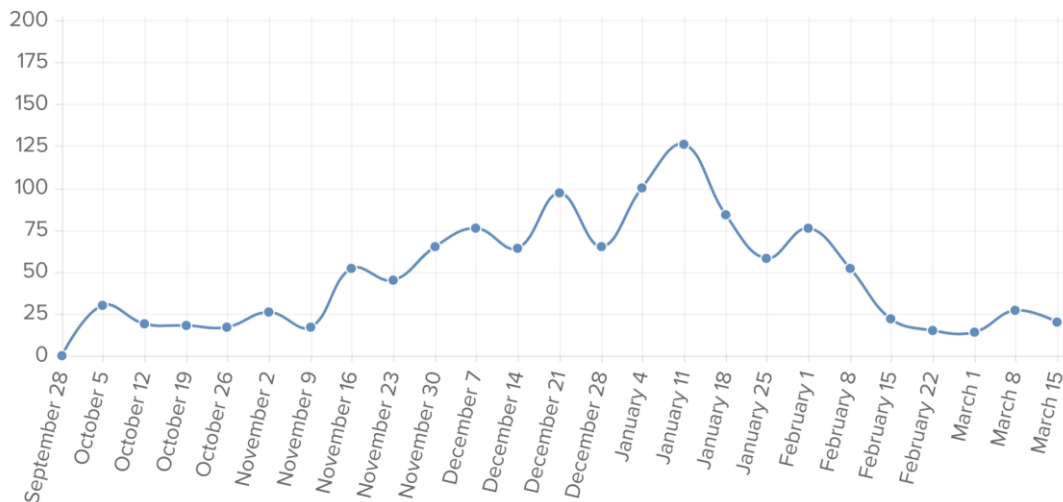
## HUDSON COVID-19 UPDATE

From Monday, March 8 to Monday, March 15, 2021, the Hudson Board of Health was informed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) about 20 additional Hudson residents with a confirmed positive test result for COVID-19. The number of residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 in Hudson is now 1424.
