## **HUDSON COVID-19 UPDATE**

From Monday, April 13 to Monday, April 20, 2020, the Hudson Board of Health was informed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) about 23 additional Hudson residents with a confirmed positive test result for COVID-19. The number of residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 in Hudson is now 70.
