## HUDSON COVID-19 UPDATE

From Monday, May 4 to Monday, May 11, 2020, the Hudson Board of Health was informed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) about 29 additional Hudson residents with a confirmed positive test result for COVID-19. The number of residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 in Hudson is now 146.
