HUDSON COVID-19 UPDATE

From Monday, June 21 to Monday, June 28, 2021, the total number of residents who tested positive for COVID-19 in Hudson remained at 1628. There were no additional cases reported to the Hudson Board of Health by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH).
