Green Hudson along with the Hudson Health and Recreation Departments, invite the Hudson community to join us in the 2020 Great Massachusetts Clean-up, sponsored by Keep Massachusetts Beautiful! Join up with your neighbors, friends and family to clean up our streets and parks to keep Hudson beautiful.

On Saturday, October 17 (rain date, Sunday the 18th) Green Hudson volunteers will be at two locations: the Rimkus Clubhouse at Riverside Park and by the Deck Hockey Rink on Municipal Drive, from 9am to 2pm to hand out trash collection bags and recycling information, and to dispose of the trash that you've collected.

We encourage residents to work in small teams that are comfortable maintaining appropriate social distance with masks. If you are interested in participating, email your planned clean-up location to cleanup@greenhudson.org or we will have maps at our locations showing the streets and parks that are in need of volunteers.

Thanks for volunteering! Please follow these guidelines and have fun!

- Please stay at home if you are feeling sick.
- Stay 6 feet apart from other groups & wear a mask when near others.
- Be aware of your surroundings (watch for cars, bikes & pedestrians)
- Always face oncoming traffic when walking on the street.
- Wear gloves when you pick up trash.
- Do not overfill the bags as they may rip.
- Return filled bags to the pick-up / drop-off locations.
- Keep safe by washing your hands thoroughly & using hand sanitizer.
- Please do not pick up the following items: sharp objects, hazardous waste, unidentifiable or chemical containers, large/heavy items. Let us know where these items are so we can get them removed.
