PRESS RELEASE

March 23, 2020 (updated from March 16, 2020)

On March 23, 2020 Governor Baker issued a stay at home order for all non-essential businesses to take effect at noon on March 24, 2020 and continue for two weeks. Town of Hudson will comply with this order. Effective at noon on March 24, 2020:

Buildings

All Town of Hudson buildings will be closed to the public. Police and Fire Headquarters and Fire Station 1 will be open for emergencies only.

Departments

Police, Fire, DPW, Inspectional Services, Health and the Town Clerk will remain available to the public via email and telephone.

Other departments will be staffed remotely. Online services will be maintained. These departments may have limited voicemail capabilities. Our phone system does not allow forwarding to remote land lines or cell phones, so our ability to take calls will be severely curtailed. The best method to reach departments is via email. While not all email addresses are on our department webpages, our standard nomenclature is first initial, last name @townofhudson.org. For example: tmoses@townofhudson.org.
