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BALLOT QUESTION (May 8, 2023)

Shall the Town of Hudson be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so called, the amounts required to pay for the bond issued for the design, engineering, permitting and construction costs of an operations facility for the Department of Public Works to be located at 1 Municipal Drive, Hudson, MA 01749, shown on Assessor Map 13, as Parcel 66, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto?

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Article

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate Twenty-Three Million Six Hundred Thousand (\$23,600,000.00) Dollars, or any other a sum of money, for the design, engineering, permitting and construction costs of a new operations facility for the Department of Public Works to be located at 1 Municipal Drive, Hudson, MA 01749, shown on Assessor Map 13, as Parcel 66, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by borrowing or otherwise; that the approval of the Town's borrowing under this article shall be subject to and contingent upon an affirmative vote of the Town to exempt the amounts required for the payment of interest and principal on said borrowing from the limitations on taxes imposed by General Laws, Chapter 59, Section 21C (Proposition 2 ½); or to take any other action relative thereto.

Vote

Voted: that \$23,600,000 is appropriated for the design, engineering, permitting and construction costs of a new operations facility for the Department of Public Works to be located at 1 Municipal Drive, Hudson, MA 01749, shown on Assessor Map 13, as Parcel 66; that to meet this appropriation the Treasurer with the approval of the Select Board is authorized to borrow \$23,600,000 under G.L. c.44, §7(1) or any other enabling authority; and that the Select Board is authorized to take any other action necessary to carry out this project; provided, however, that this vote shall not take effect until the Town votes to exempt from the limitation on total taxes imposed by G.L. c.59, §21C (Proposition 2½) amounts required to pay the principal of and interest on the borrowing authorized by this vote.
