Regional Youth Substance Abuse Prevention

Program Coordinator

The Hudson Health Department seeks qualified candidates for the position of *Regional Youth Substance Abuse Prevention Program Coordinator*. The Town of Hudson has been awarded MassCALL3 grant funds from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health's Bureau of Substance Abuse Services to prevent and/or reduce misuse of 'substances of first use' (e.g. alcohol, nicotine, cannabis) in the Central MetroWest region. Hudson serves as the lead municipality for the regional collaborative that is made up of Ashland, Marlborough, Natick, Northborough, Southborough and Westborough. The purpose of the grant is to implement evidence-informed strategies that can be sustained through local policy, practice, and systems change to prevent and reduce substance misuse in the community, and, through those efforts, begin to close existing gaps in health outcomes.

The RYSAP Program Coordinator oversees the part-time Regional Youth Substance Abuse Prevention Program Assistant and works in partnership with liaisons from the partner municipalities to plan, implement and evaluate regional substance use prevention strategies.

Bilingual candidates strongly encouraged to apply.

This is a full-time, non-union, grant-funded position. Annual salary range will be \$50,000 - \$65,000.
