VOTE BY MAIL in 2021

Currently, no-excuse voting by mail has been extended by the state law until June 30, 2021. No-excuse voting by mail is a type of early voting, and it is available for all elections held on or before June 30. If you are applying to vote by mail in a town election or special election being held on or before June 30, you may use the VOTE BY MAIL APPLICATION to request your ballot.

The Massachusetts Legislature is currently considering proposals that could make noexcuse voting by mail a permanent option for all elections.

Or you may request an absentee Ballot:

ABSENTEE BALLOT ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for an absentee ballot, you must:

- 1. Be away from your city/town on Election Day; or
- 2. Have a disability that keeps you from voting at your polling place; or

3. Have a religious belief that prevents you from voting at your polling place on Election Day.

For elections held through June 30, 2021, state law clarifies that any person taking precautions relating to COVID-19 qualifies for an absentee ballot by reason of physical disability. THIS INCLUDES THE HUDSON ANNUAL ELECTION ON MAY 10, 2021.
